

**Town of Sudlersville**  
**Commissioners Workshop Meeting**  
**February 16, 2011 6:30 pm**

President Faust called the meeting to order

The Pledge of Allegiance was said

In attendance were all of the Commissioners and Clerk/Treasurer Nicole Hilliard

Commissioner Price moved to approve the previous meeting minutes from February 2, 2011, seconded by Commissioner Engrem. Approved 5-0

President Faust spoke about his time at the Maryland Mayors Convention

The Commissioners discussed the Addendum submitted by Rettew for additional engineering services for the water project. Commissioner Faust moved to hold off on the addendum until the meeting on March 2, 2011 and request Rettew to attend the meeting at no cost to the Town, to explain the additional cost and answer the Commissioners questions. Commissioner Price seconded the motion. Approved 5-0

Nicole is to advise Chris Frawley from Rettew of the meeting and also let him know that a breakdown of the charges and Joe Scott's billable hours is expected, and that this meeting or the supplies for it are not to be billed to the Town. Any other information that the Commissioners would like from Rettew should be emailed to Nicole so that it can be forwarded to Rettew.

Commissioner Kimble moved to allow the option of installing a sprinkler system to all single family dwellings. Commissioner Ford seconded the motion. Approved 5-0

Commissioner Price asked if the water lines were planned for the Leager Residence. They are not part of the current water plan.

The underground water tank must be removed. Commissioner Kimble is going to find out what the resale value might be.

Commissioner Price inquired about getting BDC an answer on the Inflow and Infiltration work done a few years ago. Commissioner Kimble will speak with Don Reed and get the numbers from him.

Commissioner Engrem moved to appoint Commissioner Price as the code enforcement liaison after his term as commissioner is over, seconded by Commissioner Ford. Approved 4-0-1, with Commissioner Price abstaining.

President Faust is meeting with Millington's Mayor to discuss the Town Manager position, and working with MRDC.

There was discussion on who would be inspecting the water connections to the homes in town, there was no decision made.

Commissioner Price made a motion to adjourn the meeting, seconded by Commissioner Kimble.
