Commissioners Meeting

August 4, 2010 6:30 pm

President Faust called the meeting to order

The Pledge of Allegiance was said

In attendance were President Faust, Commissioner Kimble, Commissioner Ford, Commissioner Price, Town Manager Dave Teel and Clerk/Treasurer Nicole Hilliard.

Commissioner Price moved to approve the minutes from July 21, 2010, Commissioner Kimble seconded the motion. Approved 4-0

Reports

Fire Company – President Faust reported that the carnival was a success and that they raised almost as much as last year.

Neighborhood Watch-Dianne Faust reported on the progress of Community Day. She requested that possibly some carnival games and prizes might be donated to draw more children to the event. Also, she requested bleachers or benches for attendees to sit on.

Library-The library submitted their report (please see attached) They are requested an additional sidewalk along the parking lot and also the placement of handicapped parking spots in the paved area of the parking lot.

Commissioner Price made a motion to create two handicapped parking areas in the parking lot. Commissioner Kimble seconded the motion. Approved 4-0

Planning Commission-Commissioner Ford reported that the Planning Commission did not meet in July due to nothing on the schedule

Town Manager-Dave Teel submitted a report for his activities for last month (please see attached report)

President Faust opened the bids for the 2009/2010 Audit:

Wm.C.Saddler & Co., P.A. - \$11,500.00

Lindeire & Company - \$7,817.00

Lindsey & Associates, LLC - \$10,000.00

Dave Teel will review the proposals and provide the Commissioners with a recommendation.

Commissioner Kimble would like to see the Maryland Rural Water Association artwork on the watertank. He submitted drawings from Harbor Sales showing where the artwork would fit on the tank. Dave Teel will get pricing on the proposed artwork and report back to the Commissioners.

Public Comment

Dianne Faust and Faye Williams were concerned about some of the properties in town being unkept. Commissioner Price reported that these properties had been send letters from the inspector and will be followed up with.

Action Items

Nicole Hilliard reminded the Commissioners about QAC TV wanting to film the Town and that someone needed to be selected to be a town representative. Commissioner Price made a motion to appoint Commissioner Kimble and Faye Williams as the Town Representatives. Commissioner Ford seconded the motion. Vote was 3-0-1 with Commissioner Kimble abstaining from the vote.

Nicole Hilliard requested the approval to purchase a new back up drive for the office at the cost of approximately \$150.00. Commissioner Price made a motion to approve the purchase and also to allow the Town Manager to approve any office supply purchases under \$300.00. Commissioner Kimble seconded the motion. Approved 4-0

Commissioner Price reported on a meeting that he had with the Town inspector Cary Malkus. Carry will be submitting a list of properties in town that are in violation of code so that Commissioners can decide the best course of action for those properties.

Commissioner Ford reported that the Lions Club will be having a fish fry and car show on August 28th, and requested that the Fire Company bring their antique fire engine to the show.

Commissioner Price made a motion to adjourn.
